



- 1 J. Declaring that GE's alleged contracts are illegal and unenforceable, to the extent that  
2 they violate state law, including Business and Professions Code Section 16600;
- 3 K. Declaring that GE's claims for equitable relief are barred by GE's purported adequate  
4 remedy at law;
- 5 L. Enjoining GE from asserting ownership over Mr. Wilkins' inventions;
- 6 M. Enjoining GE from seeking an assignment of Mr. Wilkins' inventions;
- 7 N. Declaring that Mr. Wilkins is a rightful co-owner of the '985 patent and still owns his  
8 ideas described therein;
- 9 O. Declaring that Mr. Wilkins has no obligation to assign his rights in the '985 patent, or  
10 his ideas described in that patent, to GE;
- 11 P. Declaring that Mr. Wilkins is a rightful co-owner of the '565 patent and still owns his  
12 ideas described therein;
- 13 Q. Declaring that Mr. Wilkins has no obligation to assign his rights in the '565 patent, or  
14 his ideas described in that patent, to GE;
- 15 R. Awarding Mr. Wilkins compensatory damages in excess of \$75,000, and any and all  
16 other appropriate relief for GE's conversion of Mr. Wilkins' property;
- 17 S. Granting Mr. Wilkins an award of punitive damages for GE's oppressive, malicious,  
18 willful and/or fraudulent conduct;
- 19 T. Awarding Mr. Wilkins compensatory damages in excess of \$75,000, and any and all  
20 other appropriate relief for GE's unjust enrichment;
- 21 U. Awarding Mr. Wilkins pre-judgment interest on all compensatory damages; and
- 22 V. Granting Mr. Wilkins such other and further relief as this Court deems just and  
23 appropriate.
